KVMI Endowed Scholarship Rules

Established August 2011

- 1. Initial award to be made to high school senior
- 2. Student must be a graduate from a high school in one of the following counties:
 - a. Boone
 - b. Clay
 - c. Fayette
 - d. Kanawha
 - e. Putnam
 - f. Raleigh
- 3. Student must have an overall 3.0 GPA
- 4. One initial award to be made each year
- 5. Student may renew scholarship three times in the three following calendar years by maintaining full-time student status with a minimum 2.7 GPA. If student fails to qualify for any one year, he/she may subsequently re-qualify for the remaining original term of the award, but may not re-qualify for a second time if he/she fails to maintain qualifications for a second time.
- 6. Each award is the lesser of 25% of the amount earned on the investments, or 1% of the principal amount annually, rounded off to the nearest least \$100. Exceptions may be made, but the principal may not be diminished. All of the scholarships do not have to be the same amount.
- 7. Can have up to four students in program at one time (can be less, if students drop out)
- 8. Student must be enrolled in a four-year Bachelor of Science Degree Program in one of the following disciplines at an accredited institution located in the United States (not limited to West Virginia):
 - a. Mining Engineering
 - b. Civil Engineering
 - c. Mechanical Engineering
 - d. Electrical Engineering
 - e. Environmental Engineering
 - f. Industrial Engineering
- 9. The award will be made based upon the following considerations:
 - a. Compliance with applicable requirements
 - b. Financial need
 - c. Demonstrated participation in community and charitable functions.
 - d. Submission of timely application through established process.
